Did You Know, in the U.S.

- Among students in grades 7-12, 56% of girls and 40% of boys said they experienced sexual harassment at school in the prior year
- 87% of those said it had a negative effect on them
- Only 9% of sexually harassed students reported it to an adult in the school, and only 27% told a family member
- 1 in 5 high school girls say they have been sexually assaulted at school

This needs to stop!

SASH Club Meetings

- SASH Club convenes regularly for meetings
- At each meeting, members explore a different topic, for example:
 - Sexual Harassment Defined
 - Boundaries and Consent
 - Reporting Harassment
 - Teen Dating Violence
 - Rape Culture and Eliminating Victim Blaming
 - Alcohol & Date Rape Drugs
- We promote respectful discussion and encourage questions from all points of view. Everyone has the opportunity to speak.
